Our aim is to provide at least 5% of students and seven staff members with Erasmus mobility opportunities each year, enriching their learning and professional growth within a broader European context.

We believe everyone should have access to these opportunities, and we've established a zero-tolerance policy for discrimination, with measures in place to support students with different needs.
